

The purpose of this platform is to provide online learning resources for various Sport Ireland stakeholders.

The personal information we gather from this website includes your name, email address and National Governing Body (NGB)/Sport or organisation.

The personal information we have collected will only be used in relation to Sport Ireland eLearning or education activities. We may use your email address to confirm your place on a course and communicate course details to you and request feedback from various education courses. Your email address is required for you to re-set your password and we may send an email requesting if you would like to take part in a survey for Sport Ireland to monitor and evaluate eLearning programmes.

We may use your NGB information as statistical information to analyse trends in training within certain sports. This information will be completely anonymised, will not contain personal identification and will not be transferred to any third parties.

Sport Ireland may verify with third parties that you have completed an eLearning course but no personal information will be shared with any third parties. Third parties include National Governing Bodies of Sport (NGB's), International Federations and National and International Olympic Committees.

The digital age of consent is 16 years old. Anybody under the age of 16 must have parental consent to create a Sport Ireland eLearning profile, if you are under the age 16 your parent/guardian must contact: rmaguire@sportireland.ie

Learner records will be held by Sport Ireland for up to ten years.

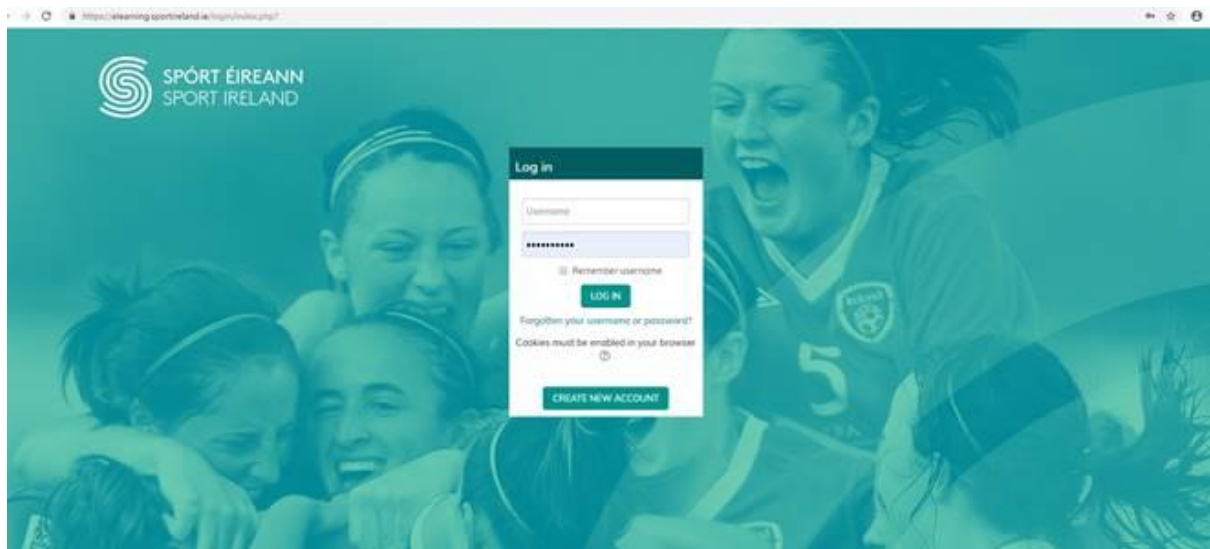

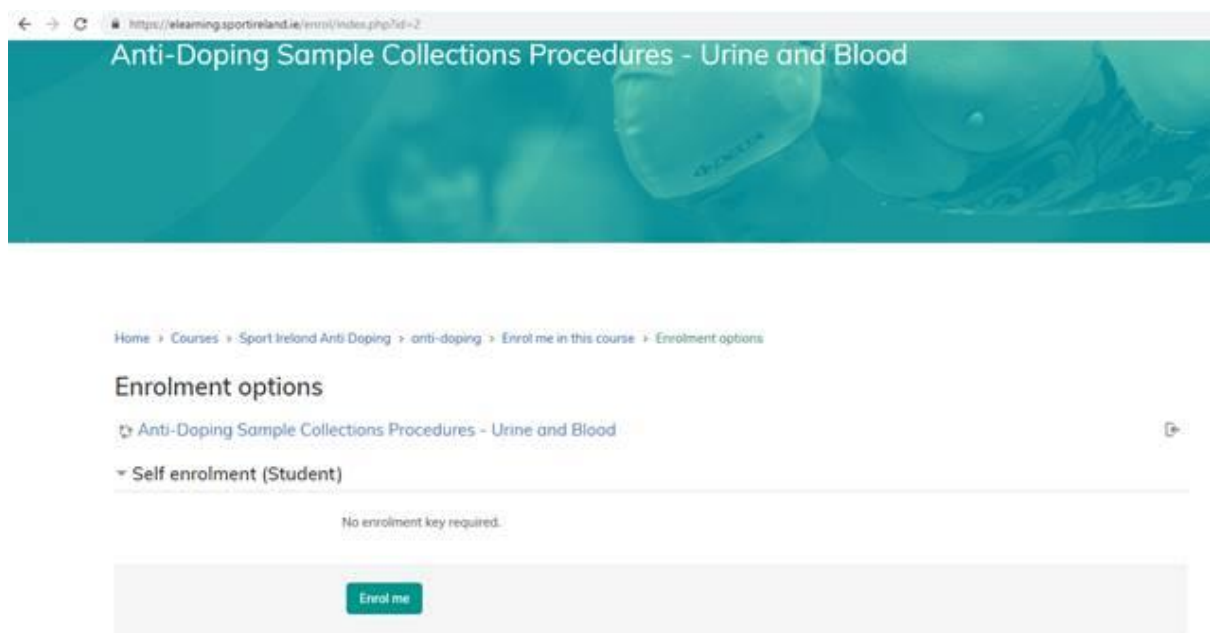
