Ireland Active is the national association for the leisure, health and fitness sector with over 350 members across Ireland. Our membership is comprised of leisure centres, gyms, sports facilities, education providers and other organisations in the activity sector. The key strategic objectives of Ireland Active are to be the voice of the sector, to represent our members, to develop policy and raise standards, to offer quality member services and to be an operationally effective organisation. We are on the journey towards compliance with the Governance Code for the voluntary sector in 2020. Our office is based at Irish Sport HQ at the National Sports Campus in Dublin with seven staff members. Ireland Active promotes, supports and protects the social and economic importance of the Irish leisure, health and fitness sector with the aim of getting *more people, more active, more often*.
