Sport Ireland will release an updated snapshot bi-annually to monitor and track progress made.



% FEMALES ON BOARDS OF SPORTING BODIES

Those with 0% has reduced from 13 to 8 since 2019

13 sporting bodies still report 10% or less females on their board (Reduced from 20 in 2019)



32 sporting bodies have obtained the minimum requirement of 30%

34 sporting bodies yet to obtain the minimum requirement of 30%

Positively 17 sporting bodies report a 60/40 gender split

NOTES

Included in this round of data are figures from the Federation of Irish Sport, Paralympics Ireland and the Olympic Federation of Ireland. More LSP data will be included in future snapshots.

For the purpose of this snapshot, where mentioned, 'sporting bodies' refers to NGBs, the Federation of Irish Sport, Paralympics Ireland and the Olympic Federation of Ireland.

Figures included have been collated from information submitted by NGBs, LSPs and funded bodies via the Core Grant Application process. Those included may change from snapshot to snapshot.
