### WHY ARE WE FELLING THESE TREES?

Trees in this forest have been affected by a disease caused by a fungus like pathogen called *Phytophthora ramorum* (*P. ramorum*). The main species affected is Japanese larch but also other species. The disease has the potential to affect a wide range of woody plants and ornamental trees. To prevent the spread of *P. ramorum*, Coillte will be felling an area 8 hectares in size.

### You can help by doing the following:

- Stay on the approved walking routes marked, including the diversions where indicated.
- Ensure that you remove soil or leaf litter on your boots after your visit.
- Wash your boots/shoes and other items in contact with the ground before visiting other areas.
- Do not remove dead wood, bark or any plant material from the forest.
- Please keep dogs on leads.
