



National Outdoor Recreation Strategy

A National Outdoor Recreation Strategy is being developed by Comhairle na Tuaithe (Ireland's national advisory body on outdoor recreation) in conjunction with the Department of Rural and Community Development. Comhairle includes representatives from farming organisations, recreational users and state bodies with a responsibility or interest in the countryside.

The strategy will provide a vision and an overarching framework for the growth and development of outdoor recreation in Ireland, creating a shared approach for the many strategies, programmes, agencies and elements in Ireland's outdoor recreation sector.

The scope of the strategy covers recreation activities that take place on land, water and in the air. It will also include activity tourism and passive enjoyment of the outdoors.
