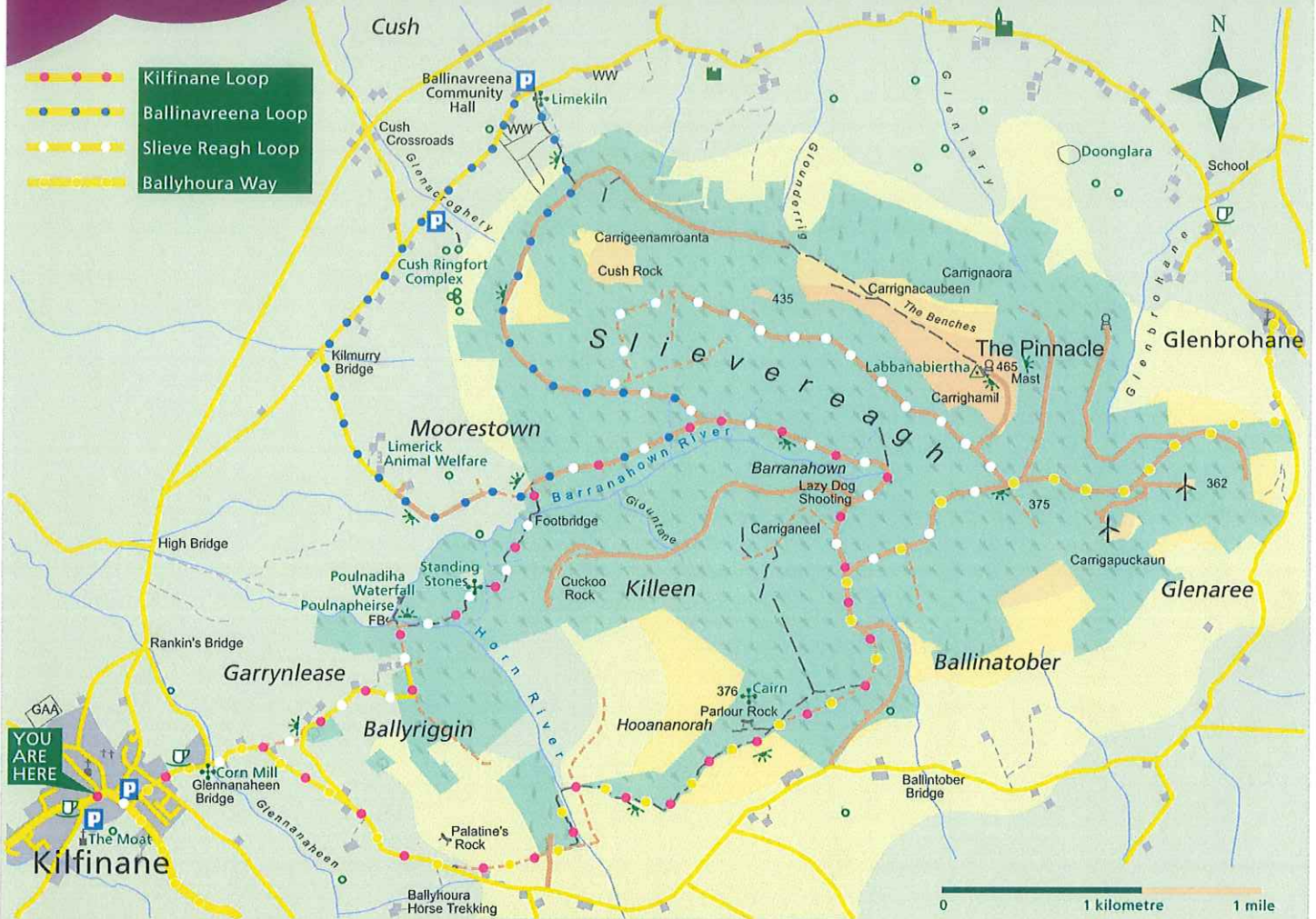




Kilfinane Loop



Kilfinane Loop

Trailhead Kilfinane Village, Co. Limerick

Services Kilfinane (0km), Charleville (19km), Mitchelstown (22km), Kilmallock (10km)

Dist/Time 10km / 3.5 hours

Highpoint/Ascent 336m/260m

Difficulty Moderate

Terrain Minor roads, winding woodland path, forestry road, grassy path

Min. Gear Hiking boots, rain gear, food and drink, mobile phone (Take photo of map board for reference)

Ballinvreena Loop

Trailhead Ballinvreena Community Centre, Co. Limerick

Services Kilfinane (4.5km), Charleville (23.5km), Mitchelstown (26.5km), Ballylanders (9km)

Dist/Time 7km / 2.5 hours

Highpoint/Ascent 302m/185m

Difficulty Moderate

Terrain Grass path, forestry road, minor roads

Min. Gear Hiking boots, rain gear, food and drink, mobile phone (Take photo of map board for reference)

Slieve Reagh Loop

Trailhead Kilfinane Village

Services Kilfinane (0km), Charleville (19km), Mitchelstown (22), Kilmallock (10km)

Dist/Time 15km/3.5hrs

Highpoint/Ascent 402 meters

Difficulty Moderate

Terrain Grass path, forestry road, minor roads

Min. Gear Hiking boots, rain gear, food and drink, mobile phone (Take photo of map board for reference)

Leave No Trace on the Loops

- 1 Be Prepared**
Ensure you have the fitness, equipment and time needed for the loop you choose. Check the weather forecast and be prepared for changing weather conditions.
- 2 Be Considerate of Other People**
Park appropriately – do not block entrances or other cars. Leave gates as you find them. Do not damage property.
- 3 Respect Farm Animals and Wildlife**
Dogs should be kept under control. Keep a safe distance from farm animals. Leave habitats, plants and animals as you find them.
- 4 Protect the Environment**
No smoking. Do not light fires. Leave no litter – if you bring it in, take it out! Prevent erosion – stick to the official trail.
