DISTANCE: 1.5 KM

ESTIMATED TIME: 30mins

WAYMARKING: White arrow on green background

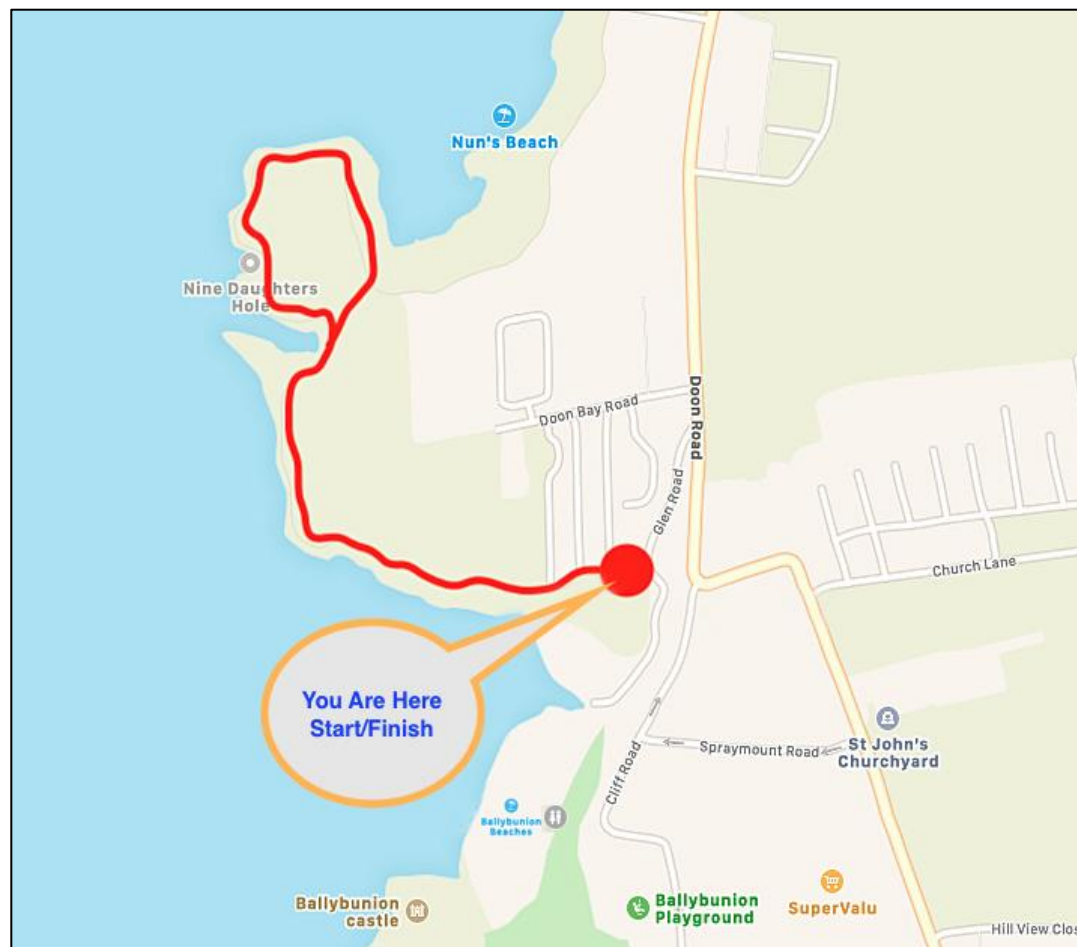
GRADING/TERRAIN: Easy – Generally flat gravel surface with some gentle slopes

CLOTHING: Wear suitable footwear

DOGS: Dogs must be kept on a lead

CLIFF PATH SAFETY CODE:

- Keep to the path, away from cliff edges and overhangs.
- Keep off the fences.
- Always supervise children, especially near cliff edges.
- Walking surfaces can vary considerably with the weather. Always wear strong footwear with a good grip and ankle support.
- Cliff-top walking can be dangerous in high winds.
- Keep dogs under close control.
- The Cliff Path is managed for walkers; it is not safe for bicycles, scooters, e-scooters etc.



LEAVE NO TRACE: Plan Ahead & Prepare – Know the terrain and prepare for extreme weather, hazards and emergencies. **Be Considerate of Others** – Respect others, be courteous and yield to other users on the trail. Be mindful that you are on private land and keep to the path. **Respect Farm Animals and Wildlife** – Observe wildlife from a distance, never feed the animals and keep your pets under control at all times. **Dispose of Waste Properly** – There are NO BINS ON THE TRAIL so bring your rubbish with you and clean up after your pets. **Leave What You Find** – Observe historic structures but do not touch them. Leave rocks, plants and other natural objects as you find them.
