Conair álainn líneach is ea Slí na Sionainne a shíneann ar feadh 35 ciliméadar, trí thalamh ard, trí phortaigh agus trí choillte. Conair mheándeacrachta atá inti, agus is é Cnoc an Fhómhair an pointe is airde ag 260 méadar. Tá píosaí dúshlánacha mar chuid den chonair, lena n-áirítear píosaí portaigh.

The Shannon Way is a captivating linear trail stretching approximately 35 kilometres, through gentle uplands, bogs and woodlands. This trail is of medium difficulty, with Knockanore being the highest point at 260 metres. There are some challenging sections enroute including through bog land.

FIOSRAIGH / EXPLORE

Is sráidbhaile álainn cois farraige ar Slí an Atlantaigh Fhiáin é Baile an Bhuinneánaigh, atá cáiliúil mar gheall ar a chuid tránna órga Brait Ghoirm. Áit iontach do siúlóidí, snámh, ióga nó surfáil na dtionta, tá Baile an Bhuinneánaigh an-fheiliúnach do shos nádúir agus folláine. Tá saibhreas staire an bhaile seo ceangailte le fothracha seanda Chaisleán Bhaile an Bhuinneánaigh áit ar féidir leat iarsmaí stairiúla a fheiceáil agus tú ag baint taitneamh as leathanradhairc luí na gréine.

Do theaghligh, tá an áit súgartha in aice láimhe ina tearmann spráíúil, gach í ach achar gearr ón trá. Bain taitneamh as siúlóidí áitiúla amhail Siúlóid Aille Bhaile an Bhuinneánaigh agus Lúb Thrá Bhaile an Bhuinneánaigh: feicfidh tú an fiadhúlra áitiúil agus radhairc ar aillte arda agus ar stacaí farraige.

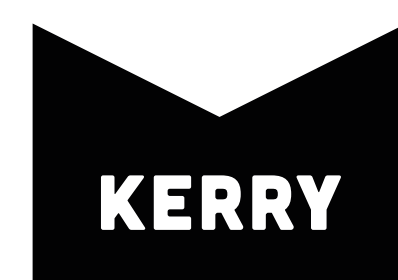
