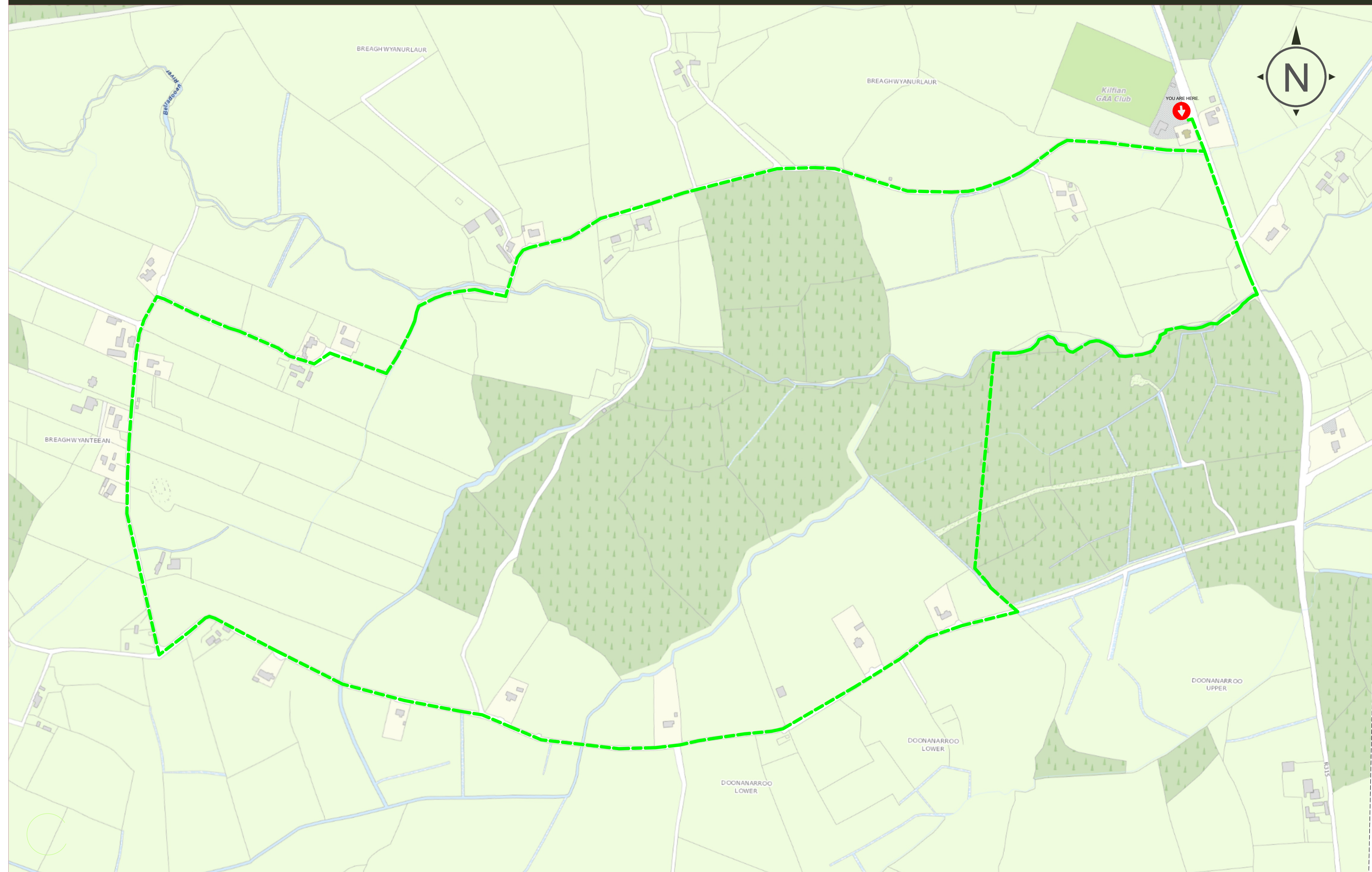

Breaffy Loop Walk



Overview

These loops are part of a countrywide network of high-quality circular walks being developed by Local Communities, in collaboration with local agencies, Department of Rural and Community Development and Sport Ireland.

The loops have been developed with the kind assistance of local landowners, organisations and community members. It is understood that if persons enter private land they do so by permission and with the consent of the landowners and no matter how often they enter, or in what numbers, they do not do so as of any right.

Location: Ratheskin/Breaffy, Kifian.
Start/Finish/Trailhead: Car park at Kilfian GAA pitch.
GPS Location Start/Finish: 54.199749, -9.352804
Distance: 5km
Estimated Time: 1-2hrs
Terrain: Largely flat route along paved rural roads and stone surfaced forest trails.

Level of difficulty: Easy.
Map Reference: OSi Discovery Series Sheet(s) 1032
Minimum Gear: Sturdy walking shoes/boots, waterproofs, mobile phone, snacks and fluids.
Services: Killala, Moygownagh.
